WHAT IS CFIM 2011 ?

- Known as Celframe FireUp Internet Manager
- Free graphical download manager for the Microsoft Windows operating system
- Light-weight,powerful and user friendly application
- Download files and whole web sites from any remote server via HTTP, HTTPS and FTP
- Allows you to download files using BitTorrent protocol
- Upload and share your files easily with other people via the internet.
- Resume unfinished download from where it has been interrupted
- Support Dial-up and High End Internet connection

Celframe FireUp Internet Manager allow you :

Celframe FireUp Internet Manager allows you :

- To organize downloaded files by their type
- Placing them in predefined folders
- To schedule a list of downloads
- Allowing you to start and pause downloading files at the set time
- To start several downloads at once and set the priority of each one
- To adjust traffic usage for browsing the Internet and downloading files at the same time
- To download whole web pages or even web sites with HTML Spider
- To use any type of connection at the maximum available speed

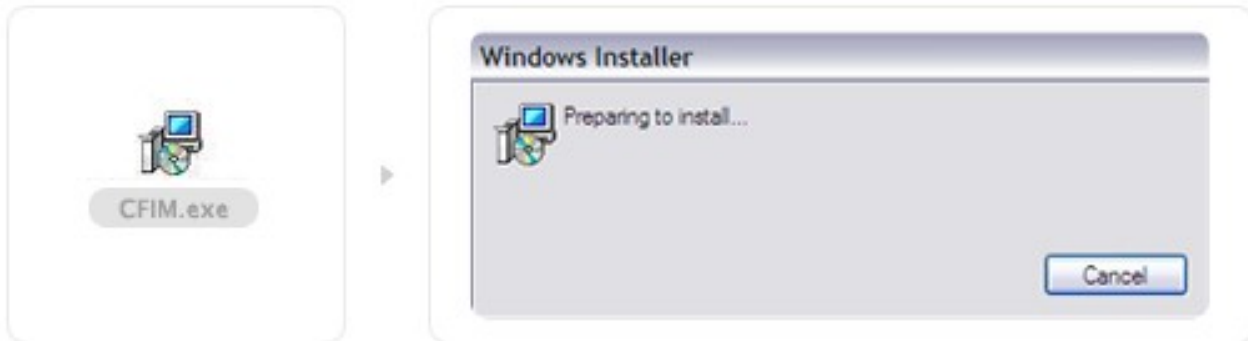

Install CFIM 2011

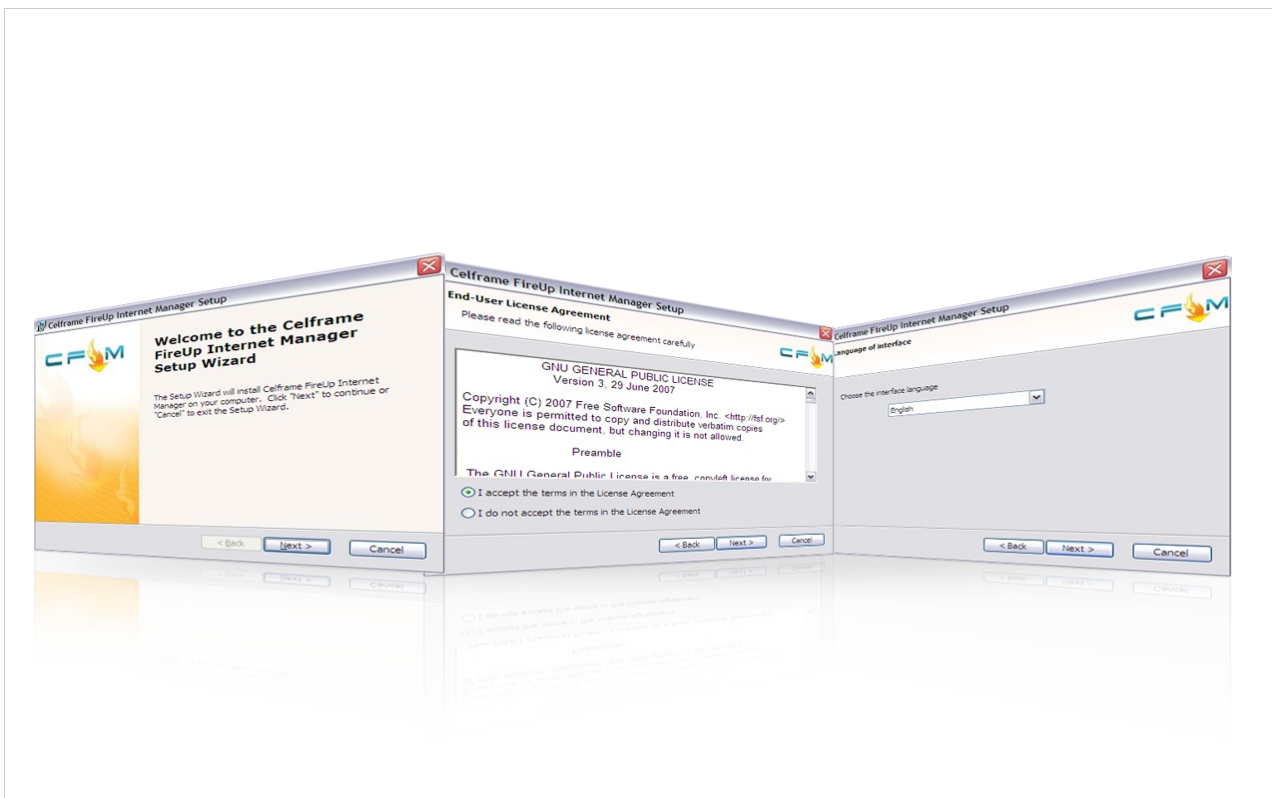
Step 1 : Click the setup icon to begin the installation



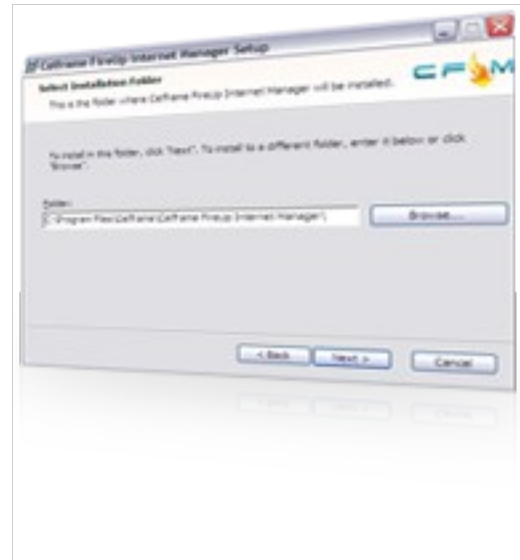
Step 2 : On the Welcome Screen, click on Next to continue

Step 3 : Accept the agreement to continue , then click Next

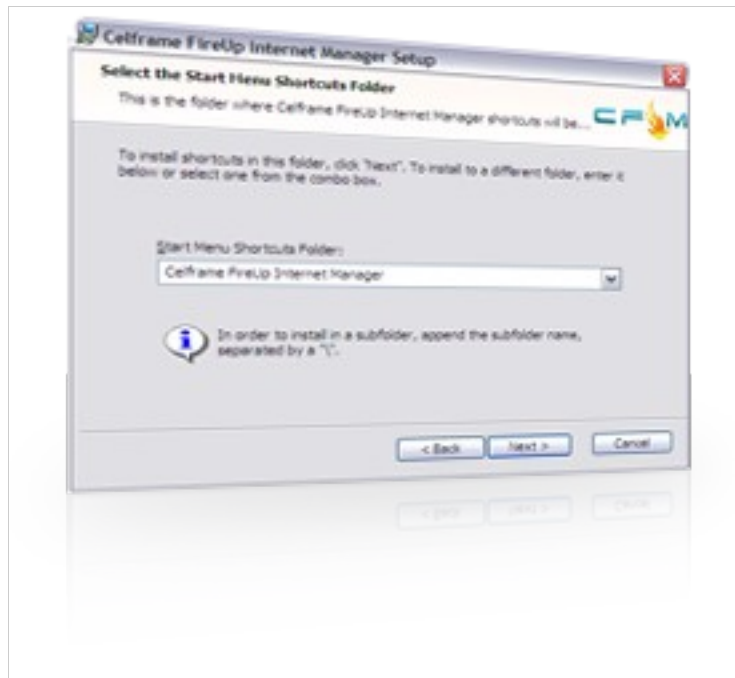
Step 4 : Choose the interface language then click Next



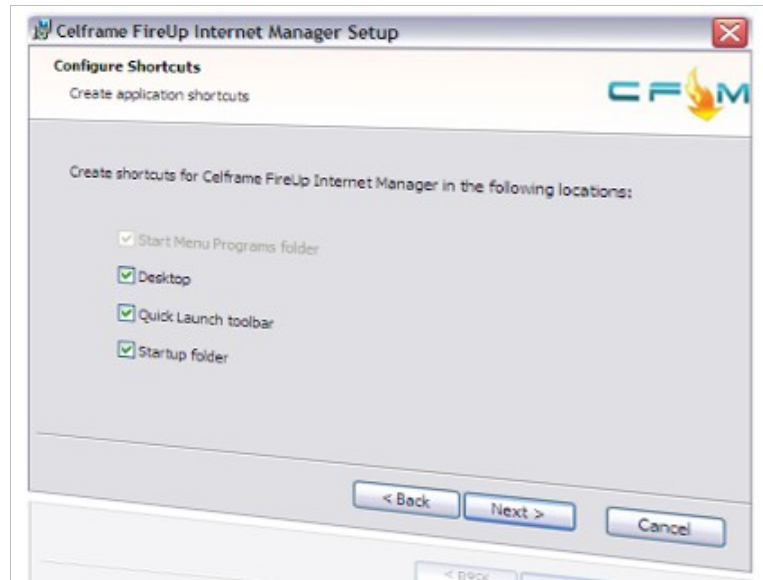
Step 5 : Select the location you want CFIM to be install



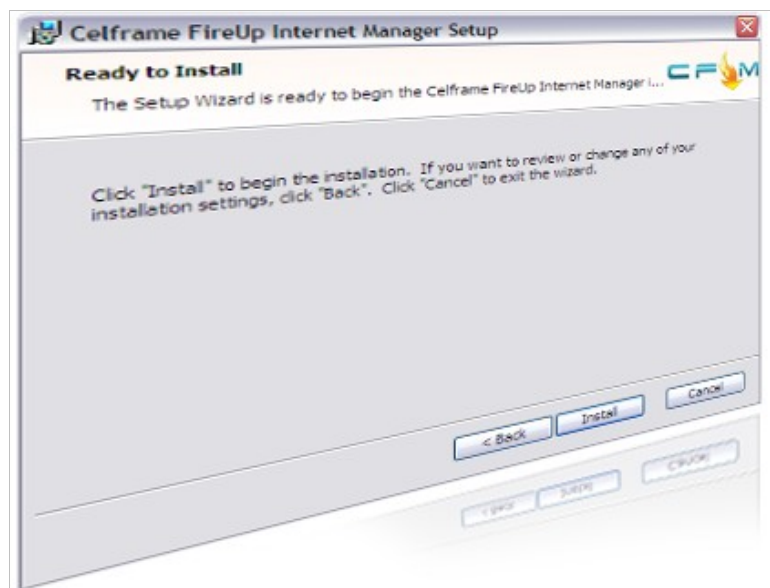
Step 6 : Select the location you want to install CFIM Start Menu Shortcuts Folder



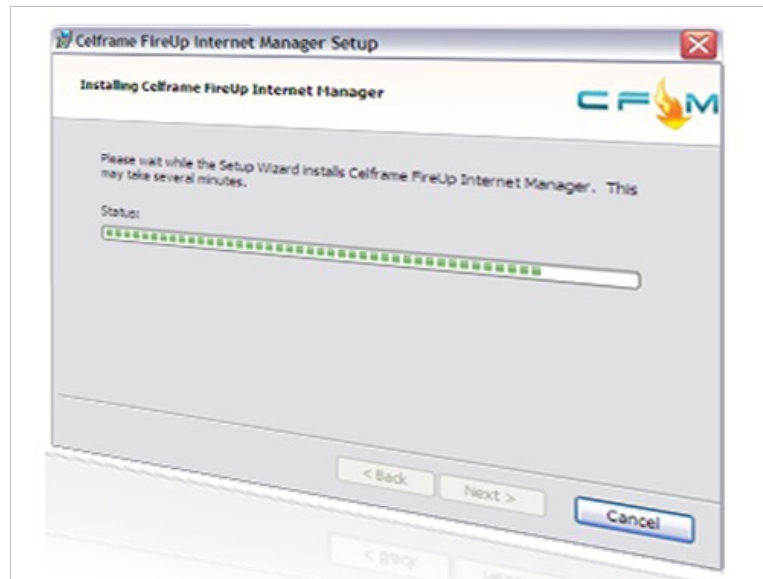
Step 7 : Check the create shortcuts if you want to put shortcut on desktop ,Quick Launch Toolbar and Startup Folder then, click Next

Step 10 : When the installation process has completed , click Finish to close setup



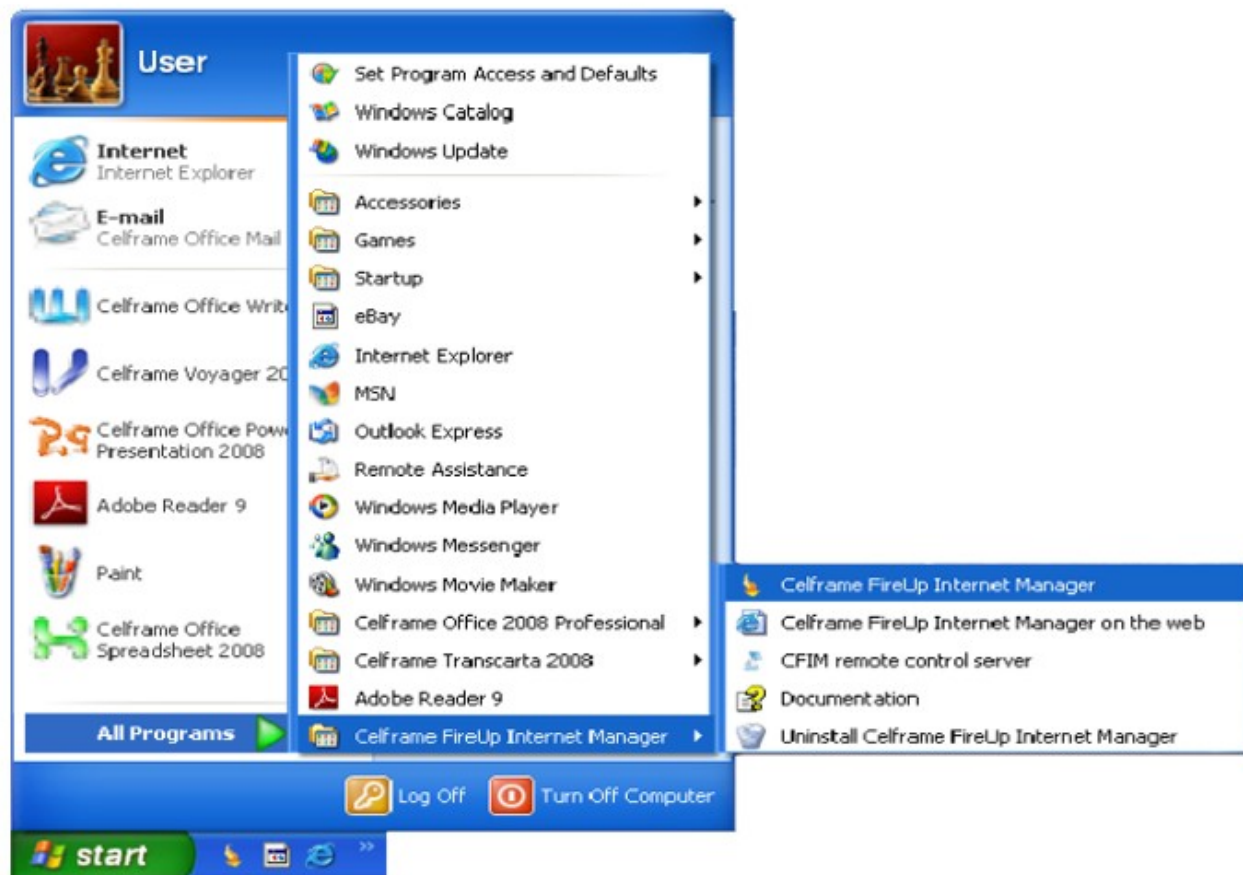
Start Using CFIM 2011

1. Click on your desktop shortcut created during the installation



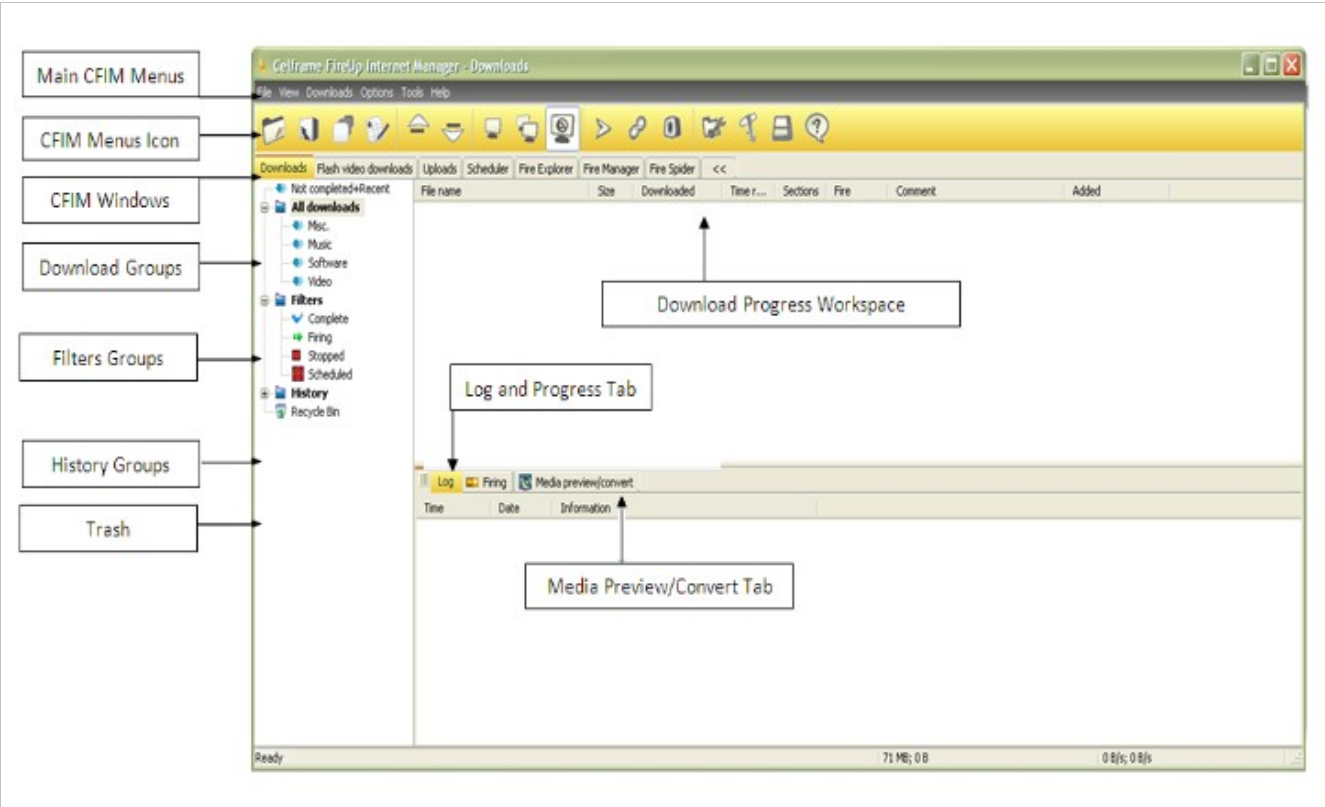

Once you open the Celframe FireUp Internet manager, the workspace will looks like this:

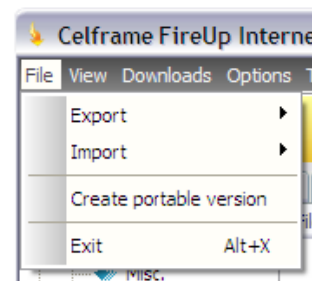

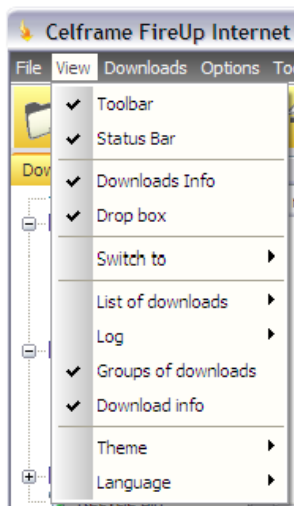
Here is the description of CFIM main window menus. Please note that different menu items are available depending on which CFIM window is open

File

Export configurations , Export downloads list , Export history of downloads
Import settings, Import download list, Import list of URLs from clipboard
Create a portable version of CFIM to use it on different computers
Exit CFIM



View



Toolbar - Show/hide toolbar
Status Bar - Show/hide status bar
Download Info - Show/hide window with information about downloading (log and progress)
Drop Box - Show/hide CFIM icon
Switch to - Switch between Downloads, Scheduler, Fire Explorer, Fire Spider , Fire Manager
List of downloads - Show/hide File Name, Size, Downloaded, Remaining, Sections, Fire, Comment and Added
Log - Show/hide time, date and information in the log window
Groups of downloads - Show/hide download groups window
Download info - Show/hide window with information about downloading
Theme - Change the skin of the program. To apply changes, you should restart CFIM
Language - Select program language

Download

Spark a New Download – Add a new download to the list

Create batch download – Create new batch download

Start download – Start selected download

Stop download – Stop selected download

Fire download automatically – start downloading the file according to network settings

Query size – Request about the download size

Restart download – Download the file from the very beginning

Advanced – Restart download, Create one more section, Stop one section, Move up, Move down, Check file integrity

Schedule – Schedule the start of selected downloads at specified time

Delete download – Delete selected downloads

Launch file – Launch downloaded file

Open folder – Open the folder that contains the downloaded file

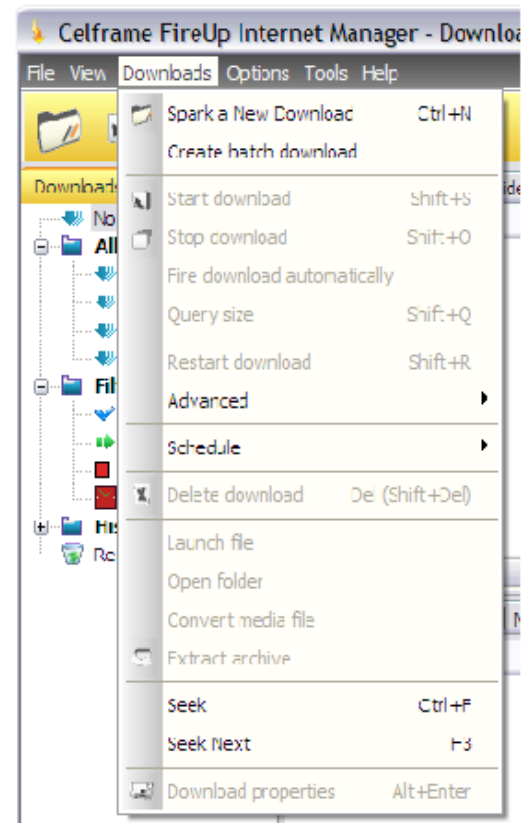
Convert media files – Set convert options for selected file (format, video size and quality (bitrate))

Extract archive – Extract downloaded ZIP, RAR or ARJ file to specified location

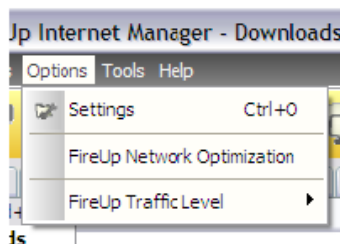
Seek – Search option

Seek Next – Search option

Download properties – Change properties of the selected download

Settings – Setting for General , Miscellaneous , Downloads and Notification

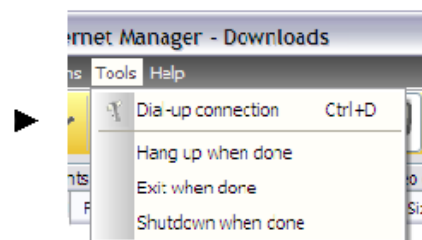
FireUp Network Optimization – Select connection type

FireUp Traffic Level – Spark : Sparking the minimal usage of traffic and the longest download time

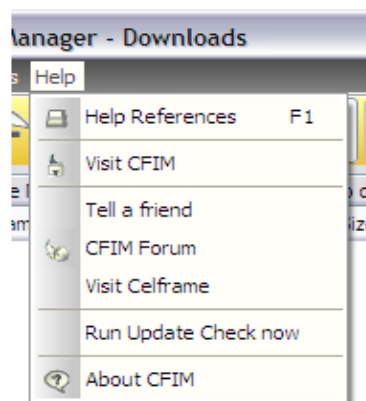
- Flame : Flaming the intermediate level of traffic usage and download time
- Fire : Firing the maximal usage of traffic and the shortest download time

Tools

Dial-up connection - Make dial-up connecton to your Internet provider
Hang up when done - Hang up your connection when downloading is complete
Exit when done - Close CFIM after completing all downloads
Shutdown when done - Shutdown your computer when downloading is complete

TRAY ICON CONTEXT MENU

The tray icon popup menu opens on right-click on the tray icon or on the always on-top drop-box.

Show main window - Show program window

Show main window - Show program window

Browser monitoring - Switch on/off your browser monitoring

Clipboard monitoring - Switch on/off clipboard monitoring

Spark a New Download - Start a New Download

Create new download - Create new download and add it to the list

Create batch download - Create new batch download

Fire all downloads - Start all downloads in the list of downloads

Stop all downloads - Stop all downloads in the list of downloads

Restrain all downloads - The mode is similar to the "Offline" mode

Last downloaded files - Show the list of last 10 downloaded files.

To clear the list, select Last downloaded files > Clear.

Fire Traffic Level - Change current traffic usage mode (Spark, Flame, Fire)







Dial-up connection - Make dial-up connection to your Internet provider


Show downloads info while in progress - Show information regarding
active downloads

Drop box - Switch on/off the always-on-top drop-box

About CFIM - Display information about the program

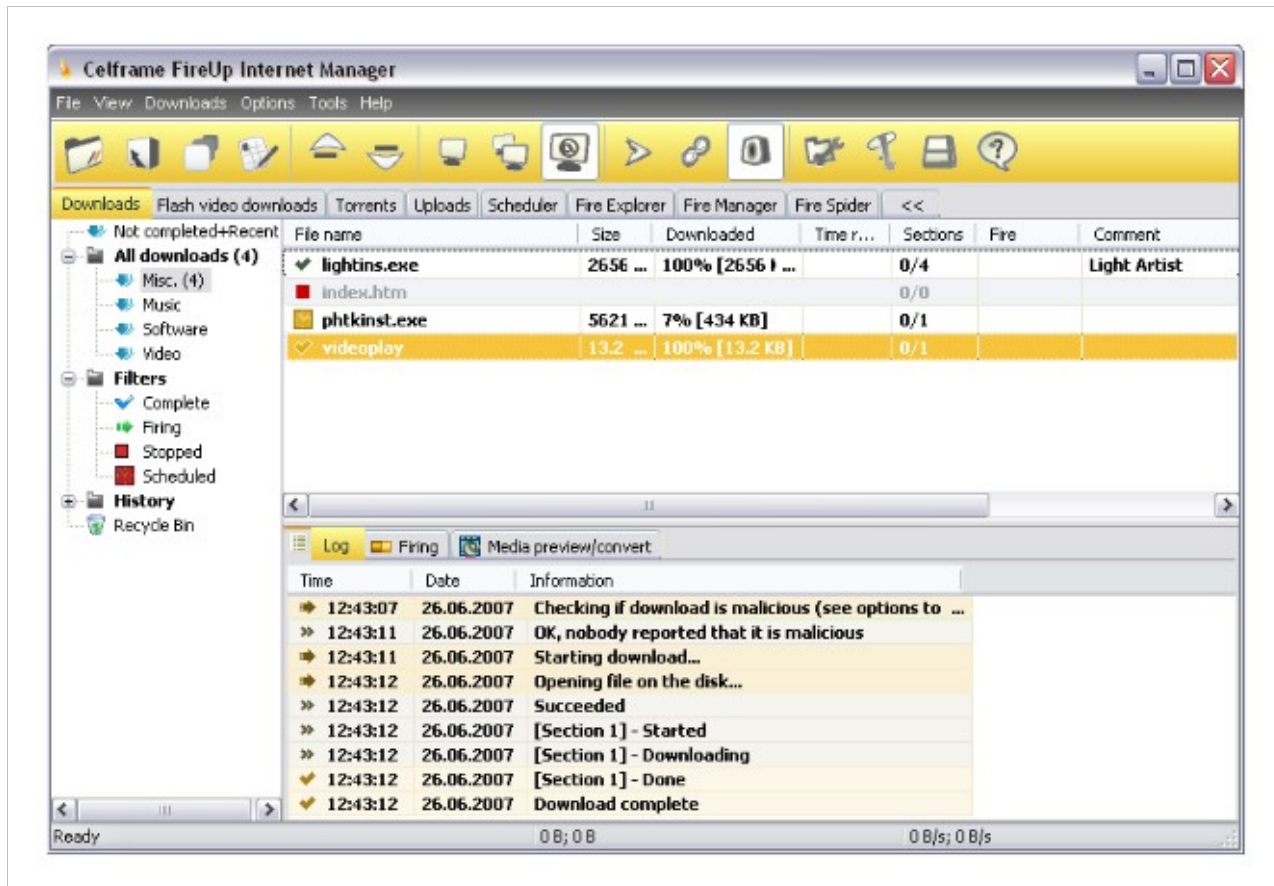

DOWNLOADS WINDOW

The downloads window displays the list of downloaded files and groups (such as music, software, video and other) and detailed status description of selected download . It also lets you to preview and convert downloaded media files.



The color coding of downloads in the list means the following:

Green - download resume is supported

Red - resume is not supported

Yellow - CFIM does not know whether resume is supported

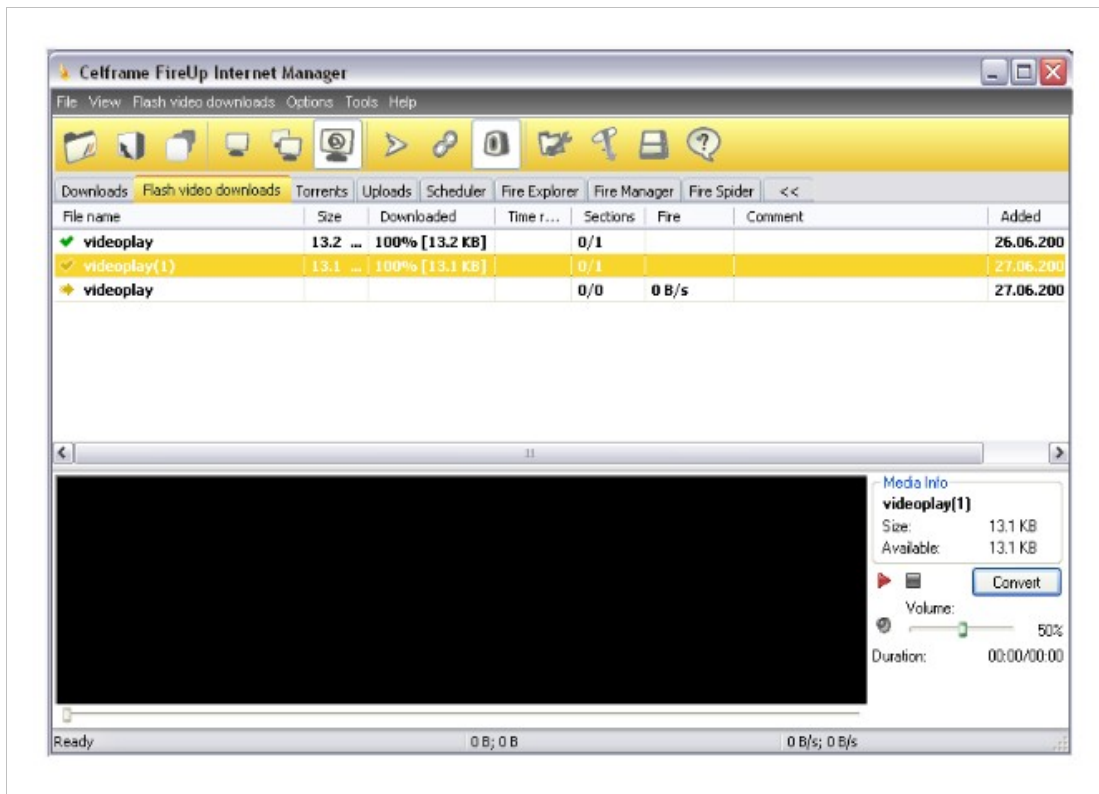
Black - download was not started yet

Blue checkmark - download is done

Green checkmark - download is done, and now it is seeding (BitTorrent)

FLASH VIDEO DOWNLOADS WINDOW

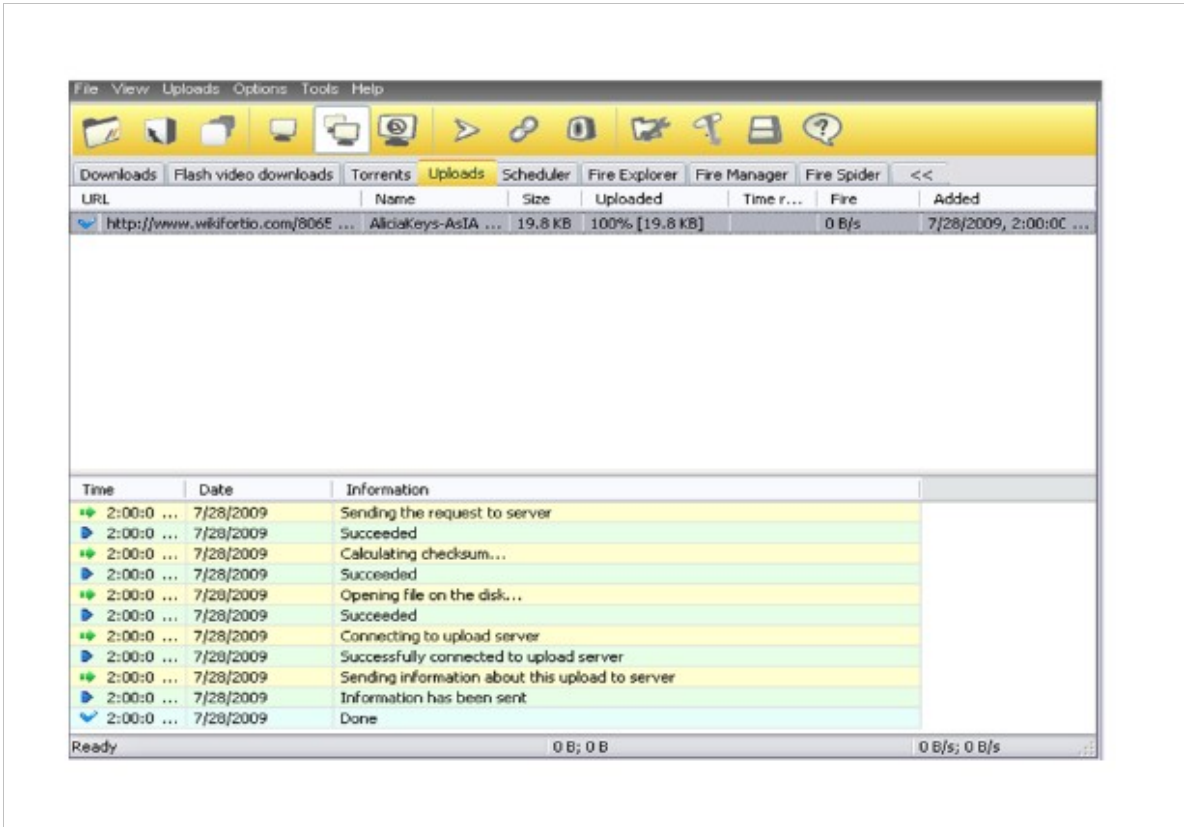
Celframe FireUp Internet Manager lets you download from video sites such as YouTube, Dailymotion, Google Video, Blennus, LiveDigital, and MySpace videos.



The window displays the list of downloaded files at the top, as well as info about the selected file at the bottom. After download CFIM lets you convert file format, e.g to AVI format. When viewed in Internet Explorer and Firefox, supported sites will have an additional 'Download with Celframe FireUp Internet Manager' item in their context menu (available by right click).

UPLOADS WINDOW

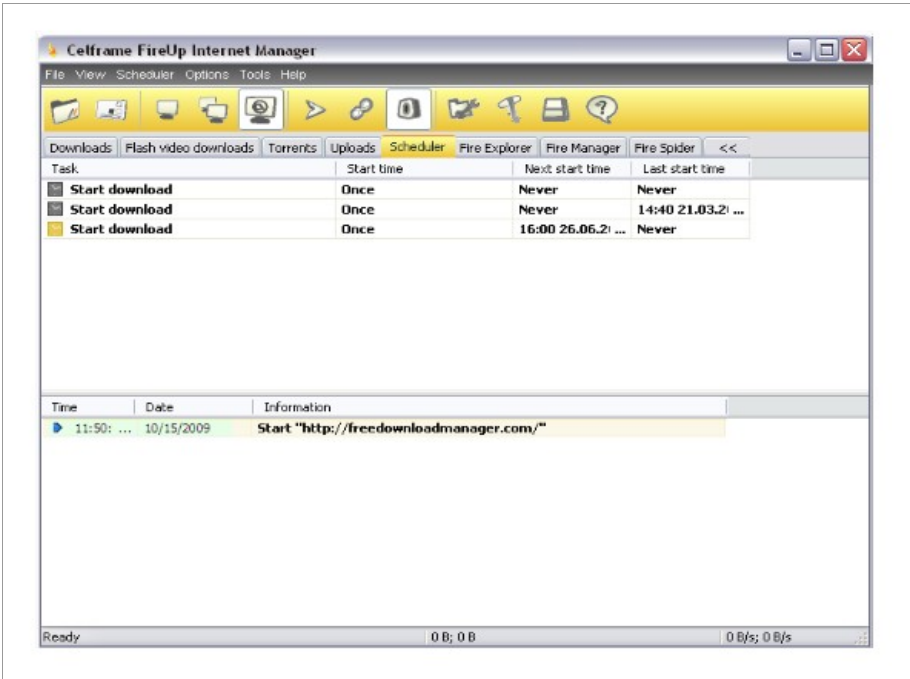
Celframe FireUp Internet Manager now lets you upload your files easily to share them with other users



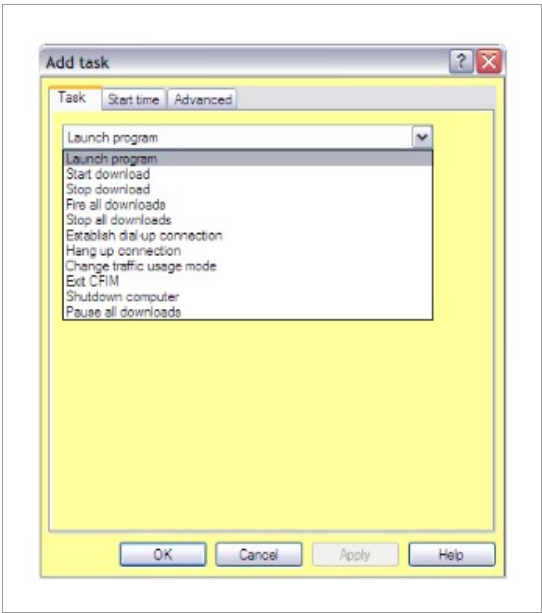
The window displays the list of uploaded files at the top and detailed status description of selected upload at the bottom.

Scheduler window displays a list of tasks at the top and the scheduler log at the bottom



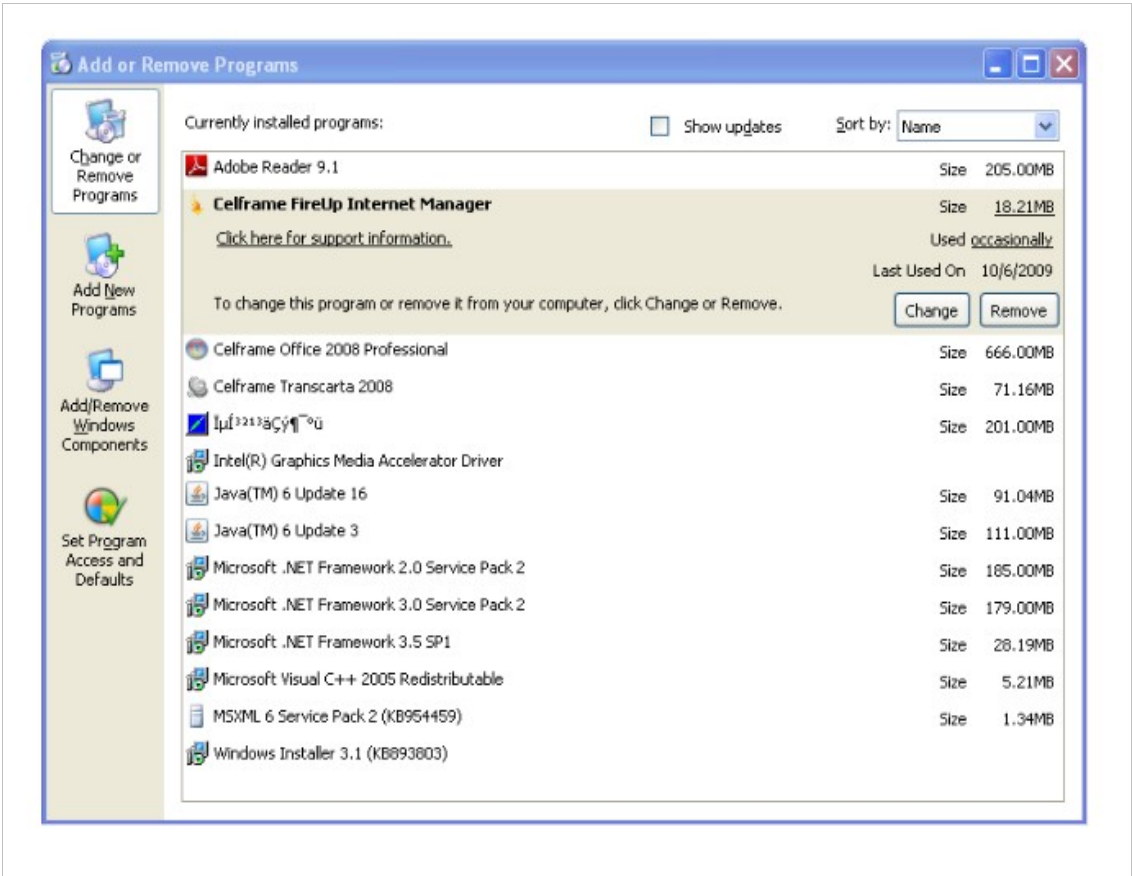

1. Uninstall

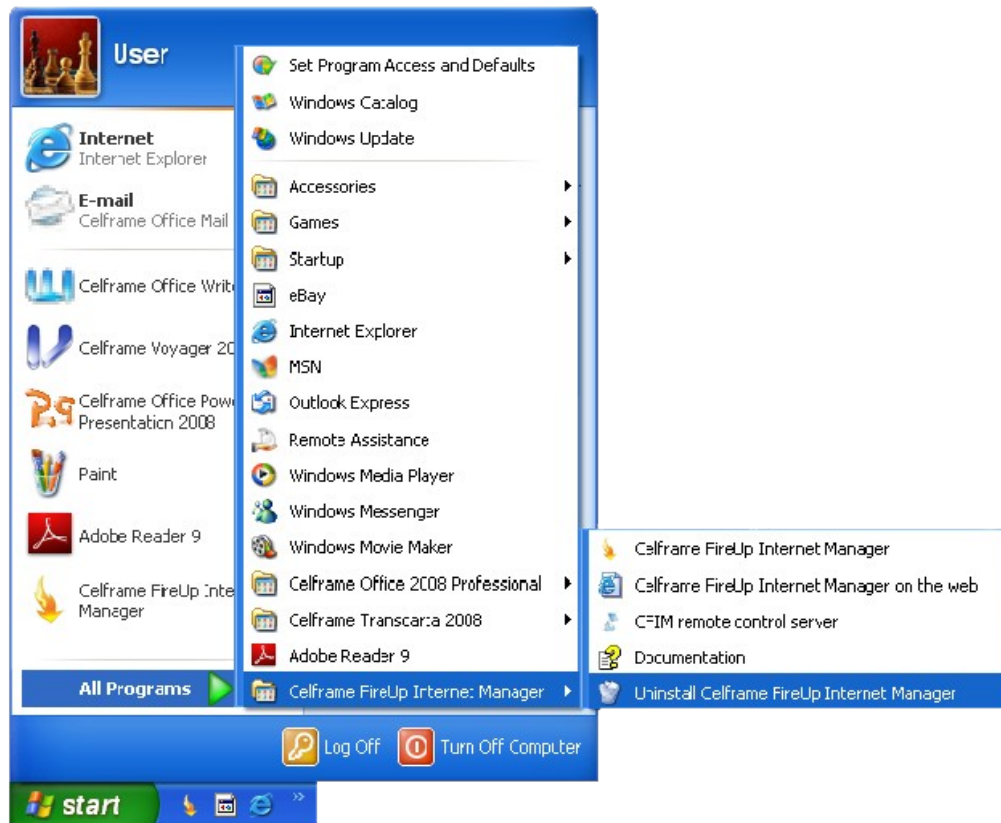
There are two option to uninstall the CFIM 2011 which is :
