

About the FileMaker Database Calendar

I do a lot of customized database development work using FileMaker Pro. I created this calendar database and everyone seems to like it so I started making it available over the Internet. It's not real fancy, but it is easy to use, works on PCs or Macs and will work over a network or the Internet if accessed by the IP address of the host computer. This is the fourth version of the Calendar. You will need FileMaker Pro 7 or higher to use this calendar.

You do not need a password to open the databases with limited access. Printing and Editing are restricted without a password. If you desire 100% access to everything including defining fields as well as printing and editing, please go to my web site to purchase the appropriate password at <http://www.macmasters.com/demos/calendar/calendar.html>. Payments are made through PayPal. The password will be displayed on the very last page of the payment process. NOTE: Once purchased, to enter the master password, hold down the Shift key (Windows) or the Option key (Mac OS) when opening the file. The Password dialog box will appear and you can enter the password.

This version has a new look, is easier to navigate through the various layouts and is much, much faster than the original version. All versions of the FileMaker Database Calendar can be downloaded from the www.macmasters.com web site. In addition I have a fully functional web version of the calendar that can also be viewed on my web site.

This calendar was not designed to be used with FileMaker's Instant Web Publishing. The Calendar can be used over the Internet but this version does NOT involve the use of a web browser such as Safari or Explorer. The calendar must be running on a computer (host) that has Internet access. Anyone (guest) wanting to access the Calendar must have the FileMaker application and Internet access. The host and guest computers must set the Network protocol to TCP/IP in the FileMaker Application preferences and restart FileMaker. Anyone wishing to access the Calendar over the Internet would need to open the FileMaker application, go to Open under the File menu. Select Host on the dialog box and click on Specify Host. Type in the IP address of the host computer and click on Open. The Calendar should then be visible in the dialog box. Select the Calendar and click on Open. The calendar will look and work just as if it were on your very own computer.

However it is also possible to view another version of the calendar with the use a web browser such as Safari or Microsoft Explorer. The web version would be linked to the actual FileMaker Calendar. This method requires the knowledge of FileMaker, HTML and Lasso (FMP versions 6 through 8) or CDML (FMP version 6) programming. I have created a sample web version of the Web Calendar that can be seen at www.macmasters.com/demos/calendar/calendar_web.lasso. Unless you are an experienced FileMaker programmer, you would need to contact me for a quote if you wanted a customized web version of the Calendar.

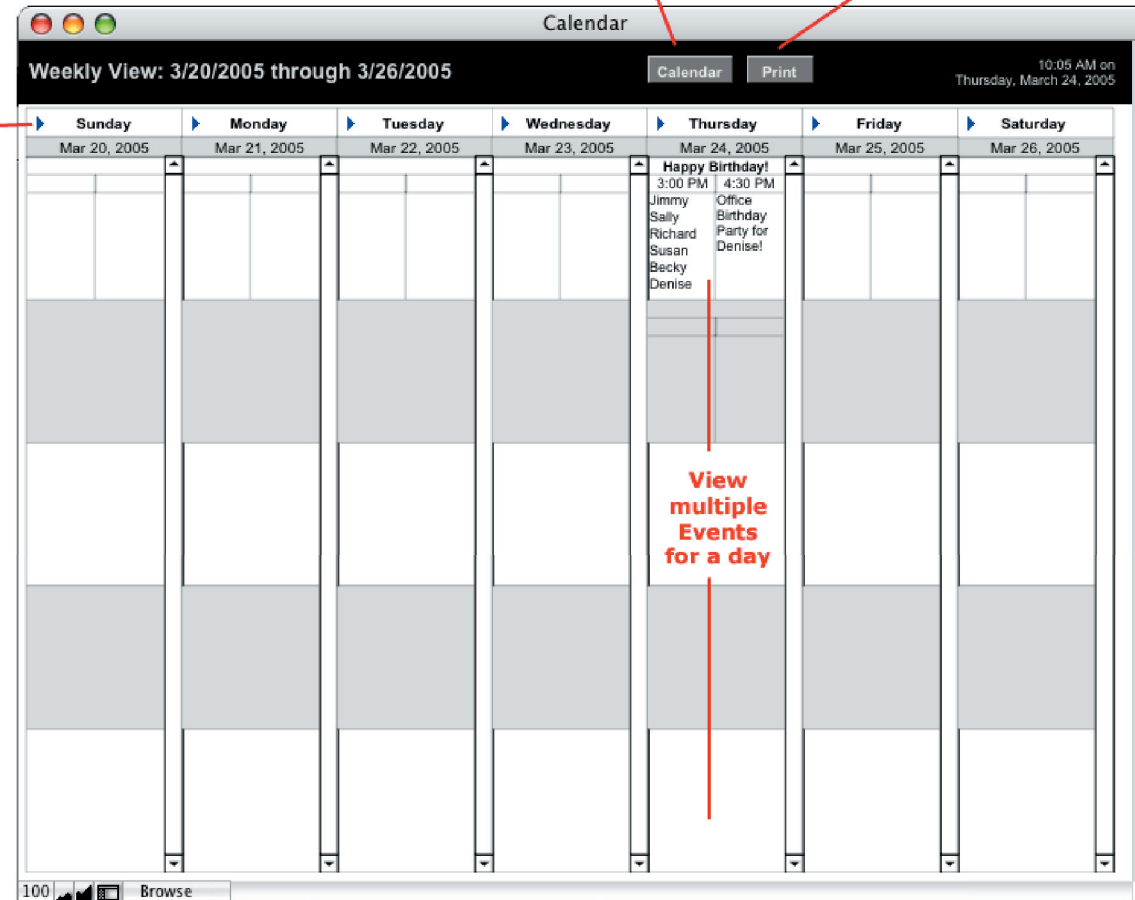
